**Overview**

The **Market Investigator** assesses and investigates potential insider trading and market manipulation. These reviews and investigations may lead to formal investigations of market misconduct and enforcement proceedings.

**Key Responsibilities**

The responsibilities of the Market Investigator include:

- assessing market referrals, complaints or tips to determine if a trade review is required
- obtaining and analyzing trading data and relevant business documents from market participants, self-regulatory organizations, and other sources
- using BCSC case management software and other internal applications
- taking statements from market participants, promoters and investors, including by telephone and in person interviews
- preparing timelines, spreadsheets and charts
- summarizing evidence and findings in memoranda and reports
- participating in proactive strategies to disrupt market abuse
- recommending stock halts and investor alerts
- liaising with staff at the exchanges and other regulators

**Qualifications**

The ideal candidate has:

- a degree in business, finance, or accounting, and 5 – 10+ years of relevant work experience or an equivalent combination of education and work experience
- knowledge of the securities industry, securities legislation, and trading practices
- ability to work on multiple time-sensitive matters
- excellent oral and written communication skills
- strong organizational skills with exceptional attention to detail

Completion of the Canadian Securities Course and other relevant courses would be an asset.
